To amend title 38, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to furnish hyperbaric oxygen therapy to veterans with traumatic brain injury or post-traumatic stress disorder.

1	SEC. 2. HYPERBARIC OXYGEN THERAPY FOR VETERANS
2	WITH TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY OR POST-

4	(a) In General.—Chapter 17 of title 38, United
5	States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1710E
6	the following new section:

10	"(a) Authority.—The Secretary shall furnish
11	hyperbaric oxygen therapy to a veteran who has a condi-
12	tion specified in subsection (b) through a health care pro-
13	vider described in section 1703(c)(5) of this title.
14	"(b) COVERED CONDITIONS.—The conditions speci-
15	fied in this subsection are the following:
16	"(1) Traumatic brain injury.
17	"(2) Post-traumatic stress disorder.".
