

House Bill 3373

Sponsored by Representatives REARDON, PARRISH; Representative PILUSO

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Housing and Community Services Department and Department of Land Conservation and Development to employ two full-time equivalent employees to perform services relating to increasing availability of affordable housing.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, for the purposes of employing one full-time equivalent employee to:

(1) Provide assistance, education and other services to local governments, developers and community members in order to increase the availability of affordable housing;

(2) Draft, review, update and recommend changes to state policy, rules, technical guidebooks and other resources relating to housing; and

(3) Perform other duties as assigned by the department.

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Land Conservation and Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, for the purposes of employing one full-time equivalent employee to:

(1) Provide assistance, education and other services to local governments, developers and community members in order to increase the availability of affordable housing;

(2) Draft, review, update and recommend changes to state policy, rules, technical guidebooks and other resources relating to housing; and

(3) Perform other duties as assigned by the department.

SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on July 1, 2017.
