## A BILL

To ensure that pre-apprenticeship programs are considered when planning health professions opportunity grant career pathway demonstration projects.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Pre-apprenticeship
- 5 Promotion Act".

1	SEC. 2. PRE-APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS REQUIRED TO
2	BE CONSIDERED IN PLANNING HEALTH PRO-
3	FESSIONS OPPORTUNITY GRANT CAREER
4	PATHWAY DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS.
5	Section 2008 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
6	1397g) is amended by redesignating subsections (c) and
7	(d) as subsections (d) and (e), respectively, and by insert-
8	ing after subsection (b) the following:
9	"(c) Pre-Apprenticeship Programs Required
10	To BE CONSIDERED IN PLANNING DEMONSTRATION
11	Projects.—An application for a grant for a demonstra-
12	tion project under this section shall include a certification
13	by the applicant that the development of the project in-
14	cluded consideration of apprenticeship and pre-apprentice-
15	ship models registered under the Act of August 16, 1937
16	(also known as the 'National Apprenticeship Act').".
17	SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
18	The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
19	on October 1, 2019.
