- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county government; to amend sections 23-2520 and 23-2521, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and 2 3 23-2503 23-2518, sections and Revised Statutes Cumulative 4 Supplement, 2016; to change the population threshold for the applicability of certain county civil service systems; to change 5 provisions relating to personnel policy boards of boards of county 6 commissioners; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original 7 8 sections.
- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 23-2503, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2016, is amended to read:
- 3 23-2503 In any county having a population of four three hundred
- 4 thousand inhabitants or more as determined by the most recent federal
- 5 decennial census, there shall be a Civil Service Commission which shall
- 6 be formed as provided in sections 23-2501 to 23-2516. A county shall
- 7 comply with this section within six months after a determination that the
- 8 population has reached <u>four</u> three hundred thousand inhabitants or more as
- 9 determined by the most recent federal decennial census.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 23-2518, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 11 2016, is amended to read:
- 12 23-2518 For purposes of the County Civil Service Act:
- 13 (1) Appointing authority means elected officials and appointed
- 14 department directors authorized to make appointments in the county
- 15 service;
- 16 (2) Board of county commissioners means the board of commissioners
- 17 of any county with a population of one hundred fifty thousand or more but
- 18 less than four to three hundred thousand inhabitants as determined by the
- 19 most recent federal decennial census;
- 20 (3) Classified service means the positions in the county service to
- 21 which the act applies;
- 22 (4) County personnel officer means the employee designated by the
- 23 board of county commissioners to administer the act;
- 24 (5) Department means a functional unit of the county government
- 25 headed by an elected official or established by the board of county
- 26 commissioners;
- 27 (6) Deputy means an individual who serves as the first assistant to
- 28 and at the pleasure of an elected official;
- 29 (7) Elected official means an officer elected by the popular vote of
- 30 the people and known as the county attorney, public defender, county
- 31 sheriff, county treasurer, clerk of the district court, register of

- 1 deeds, county clerk, county assessor, and county surveyor;
- 2 (8) Internal Revenue Code means the Internal Revenue Code as defined
- 3 in section 49-801.01;
- 4 (9) Political subdivision means a village, city of the second class,
- 5 city of the first class, city of the primary class, city of the
- 6 metropolitan class, county, school district, public power district, or
- 7 any other unit of local government including entities created pursuant to
- 8 the Interlocal Cooperation Act or the Joint Public Agency Act. Political
- 9 subdivision does not include a contractor with the county;
- 10 (10) State means the State of Nebraska;
- 11 (11) Straight-time rate of pay means the rate of pay in effect on
- 12 the date of transfer of employees stated in the resolution by the county
- 13 board requesting the transfer; and
- 14 (12) Transferred employee means an employee of the state or a
- 15 political subdivision transferred to the county pursuant to a request for
- 16 such transfer made by the county under section 23-2518.01.
- 17 Sec. 3. Section 23-2520, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 23-2520 There is hereby created a personnel office in the office of
- 20 the board of county commissioners, the executive head of which shall be
- 21 the county personnel officer. In such office there shall be a personnel
- 22 policy board with consisting of six members appointed pursuant to section
- 23 <u>23-2521 and with powers and duties provided in the County Civil Service</u>
- 24 Act. The board of county commissioners shall make appropriations from the
- 25 general fund to meet the estimated costs of administering the act.
- 26 Sec. 4. Section 23-2521, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 27 amended to read:
- 28 23-2521 (1) The members of the personnel policy board shall be
- 29 persons in sympathy with the application of merit principles to public
- 30 employment and who are not otherwise employed by the county, except that
- 31 the member employed by the county if serving on such board on May 6,

- 1 1987, shall continue to serve until the term of such member expires. No
- 2 member shall hold during his or her term, or shall have held for a period
- 3 of one year prior thereto, any political office or a position as officer
- 4 or employee of a political organization.
- 5 (2)(a) Prior to January 1, 2018, two (2) Two members of the board
- 6 shall be appointed by the board of county commissioners, two members
- 7 shall be appointed by the elected department heads, and two members shall
- 8 be appointed by classified employees who are covered by the county
- 9 personnel system.
- 10 (b) Beginning January 1, 2018, a new personnel policy board shall be
- 11 <u>appointed pursuant to this subdivision to replace the board appointed</u>
- 12 <u>pursuant to subdivision (a) of this subsection. One member shall be</u>
- 13 <u>appointed by the board of county commissioners, one member shall be</u>
- 14 appointed by the elected department heads, and two members shall be
- 15 appointed by classified employees who are covered by the county personnel
- 16 system. The four members shall select a fifth member for the personnel
- 17 policy board. The initial selection of the fifth member for a term
- beginning on January 1, 2018, shall be made on or before March 1, 2018.
- 19 (3)(a) This subdivision applies until January 1, 2018. (3) The first
- 20 appointments made to the personnel policy board shall be for one, two,
- 21 three, four, and five years. The board of county commissioners shall
- 22 initially appoint members for terms of one and five years. The elected
- 23 department heads shall initially appoint members for terms of two and
- 24 four years. The classified employees who are covered by the county
- 25 personnel system shall initially appoint a member for a term of three
- 26 years. Within three months after May 6, 1987, the classified employees
- 27 who are covered by the county personnel system shall initially appoint
- 28 another member for a term of one year.
- 29 <u>(b) This subdivision applies beginning January 1, 2018. The member</u>
- 30 appointed for a term beginning on January 1, 2018, by the board of county
- 31 commissioners shall serve for a term of one year. The member appointed

- 1 for a term beginning on January 1, 2018, by the elected department heads
- 2 <u>shall serve for a term of five years. The members appointed for a term</u>
- 3 beginning on January 1, 2018, by the classified employees who are covered
- 4 by the county personnel system shall serve for terms of two years and
- 5 <u>four years as designated by the appointment process. The fifth member</u>
- 6 appointed for a term beginning on January 1, 2018, by the other four
- 7 members shall serve a term of three years.
- 8 (c) Thereafter, each member shall be appointed in the same manner
- 9 for a term of five years, except that any person appointed to fill a
- 10 vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of a term shall be appointed in
- 11 the same manner for the remainder of the term. Each member of the board
- 12 shall hold office until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.
- 13 (4) The board of county commissioners and elected department heads
- 14 may remove any member of the personnel policy board for neglect of duty
- 15 or misconduct in office after first giving him or her a copy of the
- 16 reasons for removal and providing for the member to be heard publicly
- 17 before the commissioners and elected department heads. A copy of the
- 18 charges and a transcript of the record of the hearing shall be filed with
- 19 the county clerk.
- 20 (5) The personnel policy board shall elect a chairperson from among
- 21 its members. The board shall meet at such time and place as shall be
- 22 specified by call of the chairperson or the county personnel officer. At
- 23 least one meeting shall be held quarterly. For the personnel policy board
- 24 appointed prior to January 1, 2018, pursuant to subdivision (2)(a) of
- 25 this section, four Four members shall constitute a quorum for the
- 26 transaction of business. For the personnel policy board appointed on and
- 27 after January 1, 2018, pursuant to subdivision (2)(b) of this section,
- 28 three members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business,
- 29 <u>except that no business shall be transacted unless one of the members</u>
- 30 appointed by the board of county commissioners or the elected department
- 31 heads and one of the members appointed by the classified employees who

- 2 Board members shall serve without compensation.
