17	Relating to labor relations; to prohibit any public

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. For purposes of this act, the following
22	terms shall have the following meanings:
23	1. PUBLIC EMPLOYEE. Any person employed at the
24	state, county, or municipal level of government or their
25	instrumentalities, including governmental corporations and
26	authorities.

2. STATE OF EMERGENCY. A state of emergency
 proclaimed by the Governor or the Legislature under Section
 31-9-8, Code of Alabama 1975.

3. STRIKE. Any concerted stoppage of work by
employees, concerted slowdown, or other concerted interruption
of operations or services by employees, or any concerted
refusal by employees to work or perform their usual duties as
employees for purposes relating to a collective bargaining
agreement or to force a demand upon an employer.

Section 2. No public employee may participate in a
 strike during a state of emergency.

12 Section 3. This act shall become effective 13 immediately following its passage and approval by the 14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
