1	AN ACT relating to jockeys fees.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 230 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:
6	(a) ''Jockey'' means a rider currently licensed to ride in races as a jockey, an
7	apprentice jockey, or a provisional jockey permitted by the stewards to ride
8	in three (3) races prior to applying for a license; and
9	(b) ''Jockey losing mount fee'' or ''losing mount fee'' means the amount paid
10	to jockeys who finish out the top four (4) spots in a thoroughbred race.
11	(2) For thoroughbred racing, losing mount fees are as follows:
