RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Congress with respect to the export of COVID–19 vaccines to foreign countries.

1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-
2 resentatives that the United States should not export
3 COVID–19 vaccines to foreign countries, particularly to
4 adversarial countries, such as the People’s Republic of
5 China, until the date on which every citizen, national, and
6 lawful permanent resident of the United States who is eli-
7 gible to receive, and elects to receive, such a vaccine is
8 fully vaccinated for COVID–19.
