3 SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.

4 Section 7701 of title 5, United States Code, is 5 amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subsection (k) as sub7 section (l); and

8 (2) by inserting after subsection (j) the fol-9 lowing:

"(k)(1) An employee or applicant for employment ap pealing an action arising from a determination of ineligi bility for a sensitive position may not be denied Board re view of the merits of such determination if—

- 5 "(A) the position is not one that requires a se6 curity clearance or access to classified information;
 7 and
- 8 "(B) such action is otherwise appealable.
- 9 "(2) For purposes of this subsection, the term 'sen-10 sitive position' means any position so designated pursuant 11 to Executive Order 10450 (5 U.S.C. 7311 note) or, if su-12 perseded, a successor Executive order.".

13 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 The amendments made by this Act shall apply to all15 appeals, without exception, that are pending on, or com-16 menced on or after, the date of the enactment of this Act.
