A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Hunting and Fishing Licenses – Discounts, Complimentary Licenses, and Reporting

FOR the purpose of repealing the termination provisions for certain provisions of law 4 $\mathbf{5}$ relating to the issuance of complimentary or discounted hunting and fishing licenses 6 to certain military personnel, former prisoners of war, recipients of the Purple Heart 7 Award, and disabled veterans; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to 8 implement certain programs to provide certain discounted licenses, stamps, and 9 permits to Maryland residents who meet certain criteria; authorizing the Department to issue certain complimentary licenses and permits to an out-of-state 10 11 person who certifies that the person meets certain criteria under certain 12circumstances; repealing a requirement that the Department submit a certain report 13 to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; making 14conforming changes; and generally relating to hunting and fishing licenses.

(4) The Department shall implement a program to provide discounted Chesapeake Bay and coastal sport fishing licenses to Maryland residents who [are]:

To hunt migratory game birds 12the purchaser must also buy a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and to hunt wild 13waterfowl the purchaser must buy both a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and a 14federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp. To hunt deer during bow and arrow 15season and black powder season the purchaser must also purchase a bow and arrow or 16 black powder stamp.

17(ii) A nonresident hunting license that enables the purchaser to hunt 18 all legal game birds and mammals during any appropriate season without the purchase of additional stamps unless the purchaser is hunting migratory game birds or deer during 19 20bow and arrow season or black powder season. This license enables the purchaser to hunt 21migratory game birds only with the purchase of a Maryland migratory game bird stamp 22and to hunt wild waterfowl only with the purchase of both a Maryland migratory game bird 23stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp. This license enables the purchaser to hunt deer during bow and arrow season and black powder season only 2425with the purchase of a nonresident bow and arrow or black powder stamp.

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(iiii) A nonresident 3-day hunting license that enables the purchaser 27to hunt all legal game birds and mammals except deer and turkey for the 3 consecutive 28legal hunting days in a single season that are specified on the license by the issuing agent. 29The purchaser must also purchase a Maryland migratory game bird stamp to hunt 30 migratory game birds and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp to hunt 31 wild waterfowl with this license. Under no circumstance does this license authorize the 32purchaser to hunt deer and turkey.

An apprentice hunting license that enables the purchaser 34 to hunt all legal game birds and mammals in a single season without the purchase of additional stamps unless the purchaser is hunting migratory game birds or deer during 3536 bow and arrow season or black powder season.
