## A BILL

To codify the Industry-Recognized Apprenticeship Programs of the Department of Labor.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Modernizing America's
- 5 Apprenticeship Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. INDUSTRY-RECOGNIZED APPRENTICESHIP PRO-
- 7 GRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.
- 8 The provisions of part 29 of title 29, Code of Federal
- 9 Regulations, as amended by the final regulations entitled
- 10 "Apprenticeship Programs, Labor Standards for Registra-

- 1 tion, Amendment of Regulations" published by the De-
- 2 partment of Education in the Federal Register on March
- 3 11, 2020 (85 Fed. Reg. 14294 et seq.), and as in effect
- 4 on the day before the date of enactment of this Act, shall
- 5 have the force and effect of enacted law.
