A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to extend certain protections against prohibited personnel practices, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Follow the Rules Act".
- 5 SEC. 2. PROHIBITED PERSONNEL ACTION BASED ON OR-
- 6 DERING INDIVIDUAL TO VIOLATE RULE OR
- 7 **REGULATION**.
- 8 (a) In General.—Subparagraph (D) of section
- 9 2302(b)(9) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by
- 10 inserting ", rule, or regulation" after "law".
- 11 (b) Technical Correction.—Such subparagraph is
- 12 further amended by striking "for".
