A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Sexual Abuse and Assault Awareness and Prevention Program –**
3 **Human and Sex Trafficking**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education and certain nonpublic schools
5 to develop and implement a program of age-appropriate education on the awareness
6 and prevention of sexual abuse and assault; including, for students in certain grades,
7 material promoting the awareness and prevention of human and sex trafficking; and
8 generally relating to human and sex trafficking awareness and prevention programs
9 in public and nonpublic schools.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (a) In this section, “nonpublic school” means a noncollegiate educational

2 (1) Holds a certificate of approval from the State Board under § 2–206(e) of
3 this article; and

4 (2) Participates in the Nonpublic Schools Textbook and Technology Grants
5 Program.

6 (b) (1) The State Board and each nonpublic school in the State shall develop
7 and implement a program of age–appropriate education on the awareness and prevention
8 of sexual abuse and assault.

9 (2) The program required under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall [be]:

10 (i) [Taught] **BE TAUGHT** by a teacher who is trained to provide
11 instruction on the awareness and prevention of sexual abuse and assault; [and]

12 (ii) [Incorporated] **BE INCORPORATED** into the health curriculum
13 of each county board and each nonpublic school; **AND**

14 **(III) INCLUDE, FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 6 THROUGH 8,**
15 **MATERIAL PROMOTING THE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION OF HUMAN AND SEX**
16 **TRAFFICKING.**

17 (c) The State Board shall adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this
18 section.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
20 1, 2020.
