Snare Traps - Prohibition Against Use, Sale, Possession, Setting, Placing, or Maintaining Sale or Possession - Alterations

FOR the purpose of repealing a provision of law making the possession of a snare trap 4 prima facie evidence that the trap was used to violate a certain provision of law; $\mathbf{5}$ 6 repealing a requirement that a law enforcement officer of the State confiscate and 7 destroy a snare trap under certain circumstances; repealing a prohibition against possessing a snare trap in certain counties; repealing a prohibition against using, 8 9 selling, possessing, setting, placing, or maintaining a snare trap in Cecil County; 10 making stylistic changes; repealing an obsolete provision of law; and generally 11 relating to snare traps.
