## RESOLUTION

To authorize testimony, documents, and representation in  
*United States v. Pratersch*.

Whereas, in the case of *United States v. Pratersch*, Cr. No. 19–26, pending in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, the prosecution has requested the production of testimony from Greta Hasler, an employee of the office of Senator Bernard Sanders;

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(2) of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a) and 288c(a)(2), the Senate may direct its counsel to represent current and former Members and employees of the Senate with respect to any subpoena, order, or request for testimony relating to their official responsibilities;

Whereas, by the privileges of the Senate of the United States and Rule XI of the Standing Rules of the Senate, no evi-

dence under the control or in the possession of the Senate may, by the judicial or administrative process, be taken from such control or possession but by permission of the Senate; and

Whereas, when it appears that evidence under the control or in the possession of the Senate may promote the administration of justice, the Senate will take such action as will promote the ends of justice consistent with the privileges of the Senate: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That Greta Hasler, an employee of the Of-  
 2       fice of Senator Bernard Sanders, and any other current  
 3       or former employee of the Senator's office from whom rel-  
 4       evant evidence may be necessary, are authorized to testify  
 5       and produce documents in the case of *United States v.*  
 6       *Pratersch*, except concerning matters for which a privilege  
 7       should be asserted.

8       SEC. 2. The Senate Legal Counsel is authorized to  
 9       represent Senator Sanders and any current or former em-  
 10      ployees of his office in connection with the production of  
 11      evidence authorized in section one of this resolution.
