3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON EXTENSION OR ESTABLISH-**  
4 **MENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN ARI-**  
5 **ZONA.**

6 Subsection (d) of section 320301 of title 54, United  
7 States Code, is amended—

1           (1) by inserting “OR ARIZONA” after “WYO-  
2       MING”; and

3           (2) by inserting “or Arizona” after “Wyoming”.
