Mr. Perdue introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide for penalties for the sale of any Purple Heart awarded to a member of the Armed Forces.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Private Corrado Piccoli
- 5 Purple Heart Preservation Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 Congress finds the following:
- 8 (1) The Purple Heart medal solemnly recog-
- 9 nizes the great and sometimes ultimate sacrifice of

- 1 American servicemembers like Private Corrado
- 2 Piccoli.
- 3 (2) The Purple Heart medal holds a place of
- 4 honor as the national symbol of this sacrifice and
- 5 deserves special protections.

6 SEC. 3. PENALTY FOR SALE OF PURPLE HEARTS AWARDED

- 7 TO MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.
- 8 Subsection (a) of section 704 of title 18, United
- 9 States Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 "(a) IN GENERAL.—
- 11 "(1) Penalty.—Whoever knowingly purchases,
- 12 attempts to purchase, solicits for purchase, mails,
- ships, imports, exports, produces blank certificates
- of receipt for, manufactures, sells, attempts to sell,
- advertises for sale, trades, barters, or exchanges for
- anything of value any decoration or medal author-
- ized by Congress for the armed forces of the United
- 18 States, or any of the service medals or badges
- awarded to the members of such forces, or the rib-
- bon, button, or rosette of any such badge, decoration
- or medal, or any colorable imitation thereof, except
- 22 when authorized under regulations made pursuant to
- law, shall be fined under this title, imprisoned not
- 24 more than 6 months, or both.

"(2) Limitation on regulations.—Regula-1 2 tions described in paragraph (1) may not authorize 3 the sale of any Purple Heart awarded to a member 4 of the armed forces or former member of the armed forces by the Secretary of the military department 5 6 concerned, unless the sale is conducted by the member or former member to whom the Purple Heart 7 was awarded.". 8
