### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Military Mental Health5 Stigma Reduction Act".

# SEC. 2. REPORTS ON SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE. Section 741(a)(2) of the National Defense Authoriza tion Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Public Law 116–92; 133) Stat. 1467) is amended by adding at the end the following new subparagraph:

8 "(J) A description of the programs carried 9 out by the military departments to address and 10 reduce the stigma associated with seeking as-11 sistance for mental health or suicidal 12 thoughts.".
