Mr. MORAN (for himself and Mr. TESTER) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to modify the limitation on pay for certain high-level employees and officers of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF PAY LIMITATION FOR CER-**
4 **TAIN HIGH-LEVEL EMPLOYEES AND OFFI-**
5 **CERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS**
6 **AFFAIRS.**

7 (a) MODIFICATION.—Section 7404(d) of title 38,
8 United States Code, is amended by inserting “and except

1 for individuals appointed under 7401(4) and 7306 of this
2 title,” after “section 7457 of this title,”.

3 (b) WAIVERS.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Veterans
5 Affairs may waive the limitation described in section
6 7404(d) of such title, as in effect on the day before
7 the date of the enactment of this Act, on the amount
8 of basic pay payable to individuals appointed under
9 section 7401(4) or 7306 of such title for basic pay
10 payable during the period—

11 (A) beginning on November 1, 2010; and

12 (B) ending on the day before the date of
13 the enactment of this Act.

14 (2) FORM.—The Secretary shall prescribe the
15 form for requesting a waiver under paragraph (1).

16 (3) TREATMENT OF WAIVER.—A decision not to
17 grant a waiver under paragraph (1) shall not be
18 treated as an adverse action and is not subject to
19 further appeal, third-party review, or judicial review.
