A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 1 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to inmate policies, so as to provide for matters related to the housing, health, and
- 3 care of female inmates; to provide for definitions; to provide for custodian training; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 1 of Chapter 1 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 inmate policies, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "42-1-11.3.
- 10 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Custodian' means a warden, sheriff, jailer, deputy sheriff, police officer, or any other
- 12 <u>law enforcement officer having actual custody of an inmate.</u>
- 13 (2) 'Inmate' means any female who is lawfully incarcerated in a penal institution.
- 14 (3) 'Penal institution' means any place of confinement for individuals accused of or
- convicted of violating a law of this state or an ordinance of a political subdivision of this
- 16 state.
- 17 (b) An inmate shall be given adequate access to feminine hygiene products and medical
- information concerning menopause and any other health issue related to being a female.
- 19 (c) A pregnant inmate shall not be required to squat or cough during a strip search. Except
- 20 <u>in exigent circumstances, male custodians shall not be in viewing proximity where inmates</u>
- 21 <u>bathe</u>, shower, or are in a state of partial or full undress. Only female custodians shall
- 22 <u>conduct pat-down searches of inmates.</u>
- 23 (d) The board and the Board of Public Safety shall ensure that custodians undergo gender
- 24 <u>sensitivity and trauma training.</u>

25 (e) The department shall take into consideration the location of an inmate's spouse, child,

- 26 stepchild, parent, and stepparent when determining the location of the facility in which to
- 27 <u>place her."</u>

28 SECTION 2.

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
