# A BILL

- To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to require institutions of higher education to disclose hazing incidents, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Report and Educate

5 About Campus Hazing Act" or the "REACH Act".

6 SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF HAZING INCIDENTS IN ANNUAL SE7 CURITY REPORTS.

8 Section 485(f)(1)(F) of the Higher Education Act of
9 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)(1)) is amended—

10 (1) in clause (i), by striking "and" at the end;

1	(2) in clause (ii), by striking "and" at the end;
2	(3) in clause (iii), by striking the period at the
3	end and inserting "; and"; and
4	(4) by adding at the end the following:
5	"(iv) of hazing incidents that were re-
6	ported to campus security authorities or local
7	police agencies.".
8	SEC. 3. DEFINITION OF HAZING.
9	Section $485(f)(6)(A)$ of the Higher Education Act of
10	1965 (20 U.S.C. $1092(f)(6)(A)$ ) is amended by adding at
11	the end the following:
12	"(vi) The term 'hazing' means any inten-
13	tional, knowing, or reckless act committed by a
14	student, or a former student, of an institution
15	of higher education, whether individually or in
16	concert with other persons, against another stu-
17	dent, that—
18	"(I) was committed in connection with
19	an initiation into, an affiliation with, or
20	the maintenance of membership in, any or-
21	ganization that is affiliated with such insti-
22	tution of higher education; and
23	"(II) contributes to a substantial risk
24	of physical injury, mental harm, or deg-

1	radation or causes physical injury, mental
2	harm or personal degradation.".

#### 3 SEC. 4. RECORDING OF HAZING INCIDENTS.

4 Section 485(f)(7) of the Higher Education Act of
5 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)(7)) is amended by inserting after
6 the second sentence the following: "For hazing incidents,
7 such statistics shall be compiled in accordance with the
8 definition of that term in paragraph (6)(A)(vi)."

## 9 SEC. 5. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM ON HAZING.

Section 487(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
(20 U.S.C. 1094(a)) is amended by adding at the end the
following:

"(30) The institution will provide students with
an educational program on hazing (as that term is
defined in section 485(f)(6)(A)(vi)), which shall include information on hazing awareness, hazing prevention, and institution's policies on hazing.".
