A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to issue long-term leases on Federal lands under the administrative jurisdiction of the Bureau of Land Management to companies that relocate production facilities from the People's Republic of China to the United States, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. LONG-TERM LEASES FOR RELOCATION OF PRO-
- 4 DUCTION FACILITIES FROM THE PEOPLE'S
- 5 REPUBLIC OF CHINA.
- 6 (a) Leases Authorized.—

- 1 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Inte2 rior shall issue long-term leases on Federal lands
 3 under the administrative jurisdiction of the Bureau
 4 of Land Management and deemed suitable for this
 5 purpose to companies that relocate production facili6 ties from the People's Republic of China to the
 7 United States.
 - (2) CERTIFICATION REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the Interior may only enter into a lease under this section after the Secretary of Commerce has certified that the production facility to be located on the leased land will replace a production facility of the same size and type located in the People's Republic of China.

(b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF LEASES.—

- (1) TERM OF LEASE.—Leases under this section shall be for a term of 99 years. If the production facility relocated as a condition of a lease under this section is relocated out of the United States before the expiration of the 99-year lease term, the Secretary of Commerce may issue a fine to the leasing company of an amount determined by that Secretary.
- (2) Fee.—The rental fee for leases under this section shall be \$1 per acre per year.

1 (3) USE OF LAND.—Land subject to a lease
2 under this section may be used only for a production
3 facility relocated from the People's Republic of
4 China. Such companies may construct facilities on
5 such the land subject to the lease for the purposes
6 of such production, in accordance with State and
7 Federal law.
