## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to establish a space-available transportation priority for veterans of the Armed Forces who have a service-connected, permanent disability rated as total.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Special Priority on
- 5 Aircrafts and Coverage Equity Act of 2017" or "SPACE-
- 6 A''.

1	SEC. 2. TRANSPORTATION ON MILITARY AIRCRAFT ON A
2	SPACE-AVAILABLE BASIS FOR DISABLED VET-
3	ERANS WITH A SERVICE-CONNECTED, PER-
4	MANENT DISABILITY RATED AS TOTAL.
5	(a) Availability of Transportation.—Section
6	2641b of title 10, United States Code, is amended—
7	(1) by redesignating subsection (f) as sub-
8	section (g); and
9	(2) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-
10	lowing new subsection (f):
11	"(f) Special Priority for Certain Disabled
12	Veterans.—(1) The Secretary of Defense shall provide
13	transportation on scheduled and unscheduled military
14	flights within the continental United States and on sched-
15	uled overseas flights operated by the Air Mobility Com-
16	mand on a space-available basis for any veteran with a
17	service-connected, permanent disability rated as total on
18	the same basis as such transportation is provided to mem-
19	bers of the armed forces entitled to retired or retainer pay.
20	"(2) The transportation priority required by para-
21	graph (1) for veterans described in such paragraph applies
22	whether or not the Secretary establishes the travel pro-
23	gram authorized by this section.
24	"(3) In this subsection, the terms 'veteran' and 'serv-
25	ice-connected' have the meanings given those terms in sec-
26	tion 101 of title 38.".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—Subsection (f) of section
- 2 2641b of title 10, United States Code, as added by sub-
- 3 section (a), shall take effect at the end of the 90-day pe-

4 riod beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.
