A BILL

To amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to provide for a lifetime National Recreational Pass for any veteran with a service-connected disability.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Wounded Veterans
5 Recreation Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL RECREATIONAL PASSES FOR DISABLED**
2 **VETERANS.**

3 Section 805(b) of the Federal Lands Recreation En-
4 hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)) is amended by strik-
5 ing paragraph (2) and inserting the following:

6 “(2) **DISABILITY DISCOUNT.**—The Secretary
7 shall make the National Parks and Federal Rec-
8 reational Lands Pass available, without charge and
9 for the lifetime of the passholder, to the following:

10 “(A) Any United States citizen or person
11 domiciled in the United States who has been
12 medically determined to be permanently dis-
13 abled for purposes of section 7(20)(A)(i) of the
14 Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C.
15 705(20)(A)(i)), if the citizen or person provides
16 adequate proof of the disability and such citi-
17 zenship or residency.

18 “(B) Any veteran who has been found to
19 have a compensable or noncompensable service-
20 connected disability under title 38, United
21 States Code.”.
