## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Vehicle Laws - Special Registration Plates and Fund - Hunger Relief Initiatives

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to develop and make 4 available for certain vehicles a special registration plate supporting hunger relief 5 initiatives; authorizing certain persons to apply to the Administration for the special 6 registration plate for certain classes of vehicles; requiring the owner of a vehicle 7 assigned a special registration plate under this Act to pay certain fees; requiring that 8 certain fees be used only for certain purposes; requiring the Administration to 9 consult with the Department of Human Services on certain matters; establishing the 10 Hunger Relief Initiatives Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose 11 of the Fund; requiring the Department to administer the Fund; requiring the State 12 Treasurer to hold the Fund and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying 13 the contents of the Fund; specifying the purpose for which the Fund may be used; 14 providing for the investment of money in the Fund; requiring interest earnings of 15 the Fund to be credited to the Fund; exempting the Fund from a certain provision of 16 law requiring interest earnings on State money to accrue to the General Fund of the 17 State: requiring the Administration to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain 18 term; and generally relating to a special registration plate supporting hunger relief 19 initiatives and the Hunger Relief Initiatives Fund.

- 16 (D) (1) IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE 17 REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, AN OWNER OF A VEHICLE ASSIGNED A REGISTRATION 18 PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY:
- 19 (I) WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE, A 20 ONE-TIME FEE SET BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER THE ADMINISTRATION'S 21 COSTS UNDER THIS SECTION; AND
- 22 (II) WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE AND 23 EACH TIME THE REGISTRATION PLATE IS RENEWED, A FEE SET BY THE 24 ADMINISTRATION TO BE CREDITED TO THE FUND FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER 25 SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION.

- 16 (II) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND
- 17 SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 18 **(5)** THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 19 (I) FEES COLLECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (D)(1)(II) OF THIS
- 20 **SECTION**;
- 21 (II) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE
- 22 **FUND**;
- 23 (III) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND
- 24 (IV) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED
- 25 FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 26 (6) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR SUPPORTING HUNGER RELIEF
- 27 INITIATIVES, INCLUDING:
- 28 (I) FOOD BANKS;

- 3 (III) ANY ORGANIZATION THAT PROMOTES HUNGER RELIEF.
- 4 (7) (I) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE 5 FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
- 6 (II) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE 7 CREDITED TO THE FUND.
- 8 (G) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT 9 THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2020.
