A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 12-5-175 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 fluoridation of public water systems, state funds for cost of fluoridation equipment,
- 3 chemicals, and materials, and tax deduction for fluoride-removing devices, so as to provide
- 4 that communities may impose or remove fluoridation by referendum under certain
- 5 circumstances; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 12-5-175 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fluoridation
- 10 of public water systems, state funds for cost of fluoridation equipment, chemicals, and
- 11 materials, and tax deduction for fluoride-removing devices, is amended by revising
- 12 subsection (a) as follows:
- 13 "(a) The Board of Natural Resources shall have the power to require, by regulation,
- 14 fluoridation of potable public water supplies in incorporated communities lying wholly
- within this state, provided that in no case should such fluoridation be required at a level
- greater than one part per million parts of water; provided, further, that any municipality or
- 17 county and its water system can remove themselves from <u>or include themselves under</u> the
- terms of this part by referendum called by petition of 10 percent of the registered voters in
- such political subdivision who voted in the last general election resolution of the governing
- 20 <u>authority of such municipality or county</u>. This applies to a referendum for or against
- 21 fluoridation."

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
