BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	4
4503.891 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state	6
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall	7
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants	8
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to	9

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	34

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The registrar shall pay the contributions received	42

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar46receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the47

national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services directly to their clients.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with pancreatic cancer and their families.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social support services for adults who have sickle cell disease.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.497 of the Revised Code to the St. Baldrick's foundation, which shall use the contributions for its research and other programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar68receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to69special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions70for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities.71

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar72receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the73children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the74contributions for its research and other programs.75

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

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receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 77 future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 78 contributions into its general account to be used for 79 educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 80 America foundation. 81

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 87 pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 88 cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 89 scholarships and other educational activities. 90

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those contributions for scholarships for students who are members of that organization.

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 96 receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 97 university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 98 collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 99 section. A university or college that receives contributions 100 from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 101 scholarship fund. 102

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar103receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the104university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of105

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awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend106the university. The university shall not use any of the funds it107receives for purposes of administering the scholarship program.108The registrar shall enter into appropriate agreements with the109university of Notre Dame to effectuate the distribution of such110funds as provided in this section.111

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 112 receives pursuant to section 4503.521 of the Revised Code to the 113 Ohio bicycle federation to assist that organization in paying 114 for the educational programs it sponsors in support of Ohio 115 cyclists of all ages. 116

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 117 receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 118 "friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 119 incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 120 of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 121 expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 122 educational, and cultural events at the monument. 123

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 124 receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 125 fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 126 the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 127 lighthouses of fairport harbor. 128

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar129receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the130Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the131contributions only to promote and support the football team of132Washington high school of the Massillon city school district.133

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 134

receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 135 United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 136 four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 137 district shall use the money it receives under this section to 138 pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 139 sponsors within this state. 140

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 141 receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 142 Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 143 international, which shall use the money it receives under this 144 section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 145 activities. 146

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the provision of services to children, young adults, and families in this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 154 receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 155 Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 156 receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 157 to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 158 to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 159 their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 160 research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 161 the improvement of patient outcomes. 162

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar163receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the164

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thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation165organized under the laws of this state, to assist that166organization in paying for the charitable activities and167programs it sponsors in support of United States military168personnel, veterans, and their families.169

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 170 receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 171 disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 172 programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 173 families. 174

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 175 receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 176 pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 177 into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 178 be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 179 hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 180 of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 181 destination. 182

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state.

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 188 contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 189 4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 190 source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 191 designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 192 Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 193 section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 194

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cats and for educational programs concerning the proper195veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio196pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and197maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties.198

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar199receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the200rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated.201

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 202 receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 203 Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 204 corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 205 the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 206 members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 207 charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 208 provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 209 Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 210 for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 211 promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 212 incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 213 under this section. 214

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 215 receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 216 Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 217 the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 218 programs. 219

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 220 receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 221 western reserve historical society, which shall use the 222 contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 223

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar224receives pursuant to section 4503.556 of the Revised Code to the225Erica J. Holloman foundation, inc., for the awareness of triple226negative breast cancer. The foundation shall use the227contributions for charitable and educational purposes.228

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 229 receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 230 state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 231 deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 232 233 establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 234 distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 235 for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 236 managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 237 Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 238 registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 239 such payments are to be made. 240

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning river watershed.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 250 receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the 251 conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use 252 the money in support of the park. 253

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 254 receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the 255 Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those 256 contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational 257 information about beekeeping, and to support other state and 258 local beekeeping programs. 259

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 260 receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the 261 national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the 262 contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace 263 legends to inspire future leaders. 264

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 265 pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 266 contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 267 applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 268 professional sports team located in the county of that sports 269 commission and that is participating in the license plate 270 program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 271 of the county of residence of an applicant. 272

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each273contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of274the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates275that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is276participating in the license plate program pursuant to division277(G) of that section.278

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar279receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to280pollinator partnership's monarch wings across Ohio program,281which shall use the contributions for the protection and282preservation of the monarch butterfly and pollinator corridor in283

Ohio and for educational programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar285receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the286Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council287shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner288throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.289

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 290 receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 291 great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 292 America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an 293 equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of 294 the girl scouts. 295

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 296 receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the 297 Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 298 shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 299 throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 300

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar301receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the302Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio,303which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes.304

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.702 of the Revised Code to the Ohio Association of the Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks of the World, which shall use the funds for charitable purposes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar310receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the311fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall312

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deposit the fees into its general account to be used for313purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated.314

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 315 receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 316 fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 317 deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 318 used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 319 enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 320 methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 321

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 322 pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio 323 concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 324 contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 325 to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 326 in the line of duty. 327

The registrar shall pay the contributions received328pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater329Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those330contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in331the line of duty and support its charitable purposes.332

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 333 receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the 334 fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions 335 to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their 336 families. 337

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar338receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the339organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL340association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under341

Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association342shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in343administering a program to secure the proper representation in344the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent345children, and for the training and supervision of persons346participating in that program.347

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 348 receives pursuant to section 4503.722 of the Revised Code to the 349 Down Syndrome Association of Central Ohio, which shall use the 350 contributions for advocacy purposes throughout the state. 351

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar352receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to353Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the354contributions into its general account to be used for purposes355of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated.356

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in Cleveland, Ohio.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.733 of the Revised Code to the Ohio chapter of the juvenile diabetes research foundation in whose geographic territory the person who paid the contribution resides.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar367receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the368Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the369moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section370

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4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written371agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos.372

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 373 receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 374 rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 375 Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 376 used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 377 rotary foundation. 378

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 379 receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 380 Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 381 contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 382 under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 383

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 384 receives pursuant to section 4503.752 of the Revised Code to 385 buckeye corvettes, incorporated, which shall use the 386 contributions to pay for its charitable activities and programs. 387

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 388 receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 389 Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 390 maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 391 connection. 392

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 393 receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 394 Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 395 research projects. 396

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar397receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the398Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those399

contributions solely to promote and support the historical400preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this401state.402

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar403receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the404Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those405contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth406baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City.407

408 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.871 of the Revised Code to the 409 Solon city school district. The school district shall use the 410 contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in 411 providing services to the school district's students that assist 412 in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being 413 of the students. The services provided may include bereavement 414 counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, 415 sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of 416 students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, 417 suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school district 418 419 superintendent or, in the school district superintendent's 420 discretion, the appropriate school principal or appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations 421 that the school district hires to provide those services. The 422 school district also may use the contributions it receives to 423 pay for members of the faculty of the school district to receive 424 training in providing such services to the students of the 425 school district. The school district shall ensure that any 426 charitable organization that is hired by the district is exempt 427 from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the 428 Internal Revenue Code. The school district shall not use the 429 contributions it receives for any other purpose. 430

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 431 receives pursuant to section 4503.874 of the Revised Code to St. 432 Edward high school located in the municipal corporation of 433 Lakewood. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 434 contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 435 students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 436 pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 437 students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 438 emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 439 include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 440 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 441 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 442 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 443 providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 444 faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 445 services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 446 discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 447 charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 448 services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 449 organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 450 subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 451 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 452 purpose. 453

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 454 receives pursuant to section 4503.877 of the Revised Code to the 455 Independence local school district. The school district shall 456 use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs 457 in providing services to the school district's students that 458 assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional 459 well-being of the students. The services provided may include 460 bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 461

techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 462 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 463 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school 464 district superintendent or, in the school district 465 superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 466 appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 467 organizations that the school district hires to provide those 468 services. The school district also may use the contributions it 469 receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 470 district to receive training in providing such services to the 471 students of the school district. The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 478 receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 479 American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 480 chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 481 contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 482 programs on a statewide basis. 483

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar484receives pursuant to section 4503.891 of the Revised Code to the485Ohio lions foundation. The foundation shall use the486contributions for charitable and educational purposes.487

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar488receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the489nationwide children's hospital foundation.490

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 491

receives pursuant to section 4503.901 of the Revised Code to the 492 Ohio association for pupil transportation, which shall use the 493 money to support transportation programs, provide training to 494 school transportation professionals, and support other 495 initiatives for school transportation safety. 496

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 497 receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. 498 Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of 499 Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 500 501 contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 502 pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 503 students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 504 emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 505 include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 506 507 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 508 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 509 providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 510 faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 511 services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 512 discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 513 charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 514 services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 515 organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 516 subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 517 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 518 purpose. 519

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar520receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the521Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school522

district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 523 expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 524 district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 525 mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 526 provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 527 defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 528 counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 529 violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 530 The school district superintendent or, in the school district 531 superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 532 appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 533 organizations that the school district hires to provide those 534 services. The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 575 receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 576 Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 577 solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 578 driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 579 boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 580 vocational school districts. 581

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar582receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the583

friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money584to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free585emergency medical first response throughout Israel.586

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar587receives pursuant to section 4503.98 of the Revised Code to the588Westerville parks foundation to support the programs and589activities of the foundation and its mission of pursuing the590city of Westerville's vision of becoming "A City Within A Park."591

592 (C) All investment earnings of the license plate contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 593 the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 594 distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 595 section the investment income the fund earned the previous 596 calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 597 entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 598 received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 599

Sec. 4503.891. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 600 car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 601 vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles 602 may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle 603 and issuance of "Lions Club" license plates. The application for 604 "Lions Club" license plates may be combined with a request for a 605 special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 606 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application 607 and compliance by the applicant with division (B) of this 608 section, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the 609 appropriate vehicle registration and a set of "Lions Club" 610 license plates and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker 611 alone when required by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code. 612
