# A BILL

- To amend title 10, United States Code, to direct the forgiveness or offset of an overpayment of retired pay paid to a joint account for a period after the death of the retired member of the Armed Forces.

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Military Retiree Sur-
- 5 vivor Comfort Act".

# 1SEC. 2. FORGIVENESS OR OFFSET OF OVERPAYMENT OF2RETIRED PAY PAID TO A JOINT ACCOUNT3FOR A PERIOD AFTER THE DEATH OF THE4RETIRED MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES.

5 (a) WHEN PAYMENT DEPOSITED TO JOINT AC6 COUNT.—Section 2771 of title 10, United States Code, is
7 amended by adding at the end the following new sub8 section:

9 "(e) In the case of overpayment of retired or retainer 10 pay, arising from payment of such retired or retainer pay 11 for any period after the date of the death of a recipient through the last day of the month in which such death 12 13 occurs, if such payment is electronically deposited in an 14 accredited financial institution to a joint account bearing the name of the decedent and another individual who is 15 the decedent's designated beneficiary under subsection 16 17 (a)(1), the Secretary of Defense—

18 "(1) if the decedent is an individual to whom
19 section 1448 of this title applies, shall elect to—

20 "(A) forgive the overpayment on behalf of
21 the United States; or

22 "(B) offset the overpayment pursuant to23 section 1450(n) of this title; or

24 "(2) if the decedent is not an individual to
25 whom section 1448 of this title applies, shall forgive
26 the overpayment on behalf of the United States.".

(b) COORDINATION WITH SURVIVOR BENEFIT
 PLAN.—Section 1450 of title 10, United States Code, is
 amended—

4 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting ", or that applies under subsection (n)" after "under subsection
6 (j)"; and

7 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-8 section:

9 "(n) SPECIAL RULE IN CASE OF CERTAIN FINAL RE-TIRED PAY OVERPAYMENT.-In a case described in sec-10 tion 2771(e) of this title, if the individual described in that 11 12 subsection other than the decedent is the beneficiary of 13 the decedent under the Plan, each of the first 12 payments, following the death of the decedent, of the annuity 14 15 payable to the decedent's beneficiary under the Plan, shall be reduced by one-twelfth of such overpayment.". 16

17 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
18 this section shall apply with respect to payments made to
19 persons who die on or after the date of the enactment of
20 this Act.
