3 SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF STATUE OF ALBERT PIKE.

4 (a) REMOVAL.—The Secretary of the Interior, acting 5 through the Director of the National Park Service, shall remove the statue to the memory and in honor of Albert Pike 6 7 erected near Judiciary Square in the District of Columbia 8 under the "Joint Resolution Granting permission for the 9 erection of a monument or statue in Washington City, District of Columbia, in honor of the late Albert Pike.", ap-10 proved April 9, 1898 (30 Stat. 737). 11

12 (b) RELOCATION.—The Secretary of the Interior may 13 donate the statue to a museum or other similar entity, as 14 determined appropriate by the Secretary, to ensure its pres-15 ervation and interpretation in an indoor setting. The re-16 cipient of the statue may not store, display, or exhibit the 17 statue outside.
