BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article - Human Services Section 10-513(c)Annotated Code of Maryland (2007 Volume and 2016 Supplement) BY adding to Article – State Government Section 9–1C–02 Annotated Code of Maryland (2014 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Human Services 10-513.
