A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 special license plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, causes, agencies,  
3 funds, or nonprofit corporations, so as to establish a specialty license plate for members of  
4 the Georgia Tennis Foundation; to provide for related matters; to provide for compliance  
5 with constitutional requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license  
9 plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, causes, agencies, funds, or  
10 nonprofit corporations, is amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (l) to read as  
11 follows:

12 "(57) A special license plate honoring the Georgia Tennis Foundation, with the words  
13 'Play Tennis!' to be displayed across the bottom. The funds raised by the sale of this  
14 special license plate shall be disbursed to the Georgia Tennis Foundation."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph (VI)(n) of the  
17 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the  
18 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
