## A BILL

To amend the Small Business Investment Act of 1958 to increase the amount that may be invested in small business investment companies.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Investing in Main  
5 Street Act of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. INVESTMENT IN SMALL BUSINESS INVESTMENT**  
7 **COMPANIES.**

8 Section 302(b) of the Small Business Investment Act  
9 of 1958 (15 U.S.C. 682(b)) is amended—

- 1 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “5 percent”
- 2 and inserting “15 percent”; and
- 3 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “5 percent”
- 4 and inserting “15 percent”.
