A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to remove the matching requirement for a territory to use specially allocated Federal funds for Medicare covered part D drugs for low-income individuals.

1	SECTION 1. REMOVING MATCHING REQUIREMENT FOR A
2	TERRITORY TO USE SPECIALLY ALLOCATED
3	FEDERAL FUNDS FOR MEDICARE COVERED
4	PART D DRUGS FOR LOW-INCOME INDIVID-
5	UALS.
6	(a) In General.—Section 1935(e)(1)(B) of the So-
7	cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396u–5(e)(1)(B)) is amend-
8	ed by inserting before the period at the end the following:
9	"and the Federal medical assistance percentage shall be
10	100 percent for expenditures under such plan that are at-
11	tributable to this subsection and the additional amounts
12	provided under paragraph (3)".
13	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 1905(b) of
14	the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(b)) is amended
15	by striking "section 1933(d)" and inserting "sections
16	1933(d) and 1935(e)(1)(B)".
17	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
18	this section shall apply to amounts expended for fiscal pe-
19	riods beginning on or after October 1, 2017.

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
