- 3 (2) ANY OTHER SIMILARLY ACTING AND EQUALLY SAFE DRUG 4 APPROVED BY THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION FOR THE
- 5 TREATMENT OF A DRUG OVERDOSE.
 - (B) (1) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:
- 7 (I) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT
