- 1 (B) A LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE AN ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLD WITH 2 A HOUSING ALLOWANCE OF AT LEAST:
- 3 (1) \$350 PER MONTH FOR A HOUSEHOLD OF ONE; AND
- 4 (2) AN ADDITIONAL \$100 PER MONTH FOR EACH ADDITIONAL 5 HOUSEHOLD MEMBER.
