12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 5–106.

16 **(JJ) A PROSECUTION OR SUIT FOR ENFORCEMENT OF A LOCAL CONSUMER**
17 **PROTECTION CODE FOR WHICH EQUITABLE RELIEF, A FINE, OR A PENALTY IS**
