## A BILL

To terminate the public health emergency declared with respect to COVID-19.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Pandemic is Over
- 5 Act".

### 1 SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMER-

- 3 The public health emergency declared by the Sec-
- 4 retary pursuant to section 319 of the Public Health Serv-
- 5 ice Act (42 U.S.C. 247d) on January 31, 2020, entitled
- 6 "Determination that a Public Health Emergency Exists
- 7 Nationwide as the Result of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus"
- 8 (and any renewal thereof) shall terminate on the date of
- 9 the enactment of this Act.
