# SEC. 2. MINIMUM AGE FOR OBTAINING A HANDGUN FROM A FEDERAL FIREARMS LICENSEE.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922(b)(1) of title 18,
4 United States Code, is amended by striking ", and, if the
5 firearm, or ammunition is other than a shotgun or rifle,
6 or ammunition for a shotgun or rifle, to any individual
7 who the licensee knows or has reasonable cause to believe
8 is less than twenty-one years of age".

9 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 922(c)(1) 10 of such title is amended by striking ", in the case of any 11 firearm other than a shotgun or a rifle, I am twenty-one 12 years or more of age, or that, in the case of a shotgun 13 or a rifle,".
