shall incorporate data on maternal health outcomes for not
less than 1 year postpartum, as recommended by the Cen ters for Disease Control and Prevention under subsection
(b), into the broadband health mapping tools of the Com mission.

6 (b) CONSULTATION WITH CDC.—The Federal Com-7 munications Commission shall consult with the Centers for 8 Disease Control and Prevention regarding the maternal 9 health outcomes that should be incorporated into the 10 broadband health mapping tools of the Commission under 11 subsection (a).

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
