

# 116TH CONGRESS H.R. 5974

To amend title 49, United States Code, to make it unlawful for any air carrier to operate certain helicopters without a flight data recorder and cockpit voice recorder, and for other purposes.

# A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to make it unlawful for any air carrier to operate certain helicopters without a flight data recorder and cockpit voice recorder, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Helicopter Data and
- 5 Voice Recorder Requirement Act".

#### 1 SEC. 2. HELICOPTER RECORDERS.

- 2 (a) In General.—Chapter 447 of title 49, United
- 3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 4 lowing:

## 5 "§ 44741. Helicopter recorders

- 6 "It shall be unlawful for any air carrier to operate
- 7 a single or multiengine, turbine-powered helicopter with
- 8 1 or more passenger seats and 1 or more pilots without
- 9 a flight data recorder and cockpit voice recorder that meet
- 10 the requirements of section 91.609 of title 14, Code of
- 11 Federal Regulations.".
- 12 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-
- 13 ter 447 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by
- 14 adding at the end the following:

"44741. Helicopter recorders.".

- 15 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 16 this section shall take effect on the date that is 1 year
- 17 after the date of enactment of this Act.
