A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to establish a distracted driving education grant program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Distracted Driving
- 5 Education Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. DISTRACTED DRIVING EDUCATION GRANT PRO-
- 7 GRAM.
- 8 (a) Establishment.—Not later than October 1,
- 9 2020, the Secretary of Transportation shall establish a
- 10 distracted driving education grant program.

- 1 (b) Grant Authority.—In carrying out the pro-
- 2 gram established under subsection (a), the Secretary may
- 3 make grants, on a competitive basis, to nonprofit organi-
- 4 zations.
- 5 (c) Eligible Projects.—A grant made under sub-
- 6 section (b) shall be used to provide education to the public
- 7 regarding the risks of distracted driving, including texting
- 8 or otherwise using a personal wireless communications de-
- 9 vice while driving.
- 10 (d) APPLICATIONS.—To be eligible for a grant made
- 11 under subsection (b), a nonprofit organization shall sub-
- 12 mit to the Secretary an application in such form, at such
- 13 time, and containing such information as the Secretary
- 14 determines appropriate.
- 15 (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
- 16 authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to make
- 17 grants under subsection (b) \$5,000,000 for each of fiscal
- 18 years 2021 and 2022.
