Mr. Babin introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on House Administration, and Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To allow Members of Congress to carry a concealed handgun anywhere in the United States, with exceptions.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CARRYING OF CONCEALED HANDGUNS BY
- 4 MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 44 of title 18, United
- 6 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 926C
- 7 the following:

1 "§ 926D. Carrying of concealed handguns by Members

- 3 "(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
- 4 Member of Congress who is carrying the identification re-
- 5 quired by subsection (e), to whom a State or the United
- 6 States Capitol Police has issued a license or permit to
- 7 carry a concealed handgun, and who is not otherwise pro-
- 8 hibited by this chapter from transporting, shipping, or re-
- 9 ceiving a firearm, may carry a concealed handgun for any
- 10 lawful purpose, subject to the terms and conditions of the
- 11 license or permit (if issued by the United States Capitol
- 12 Police), anywhere in the United States, except as provided
- 13 in subsection (b).
- 14 "(b)(1) Subsection (a) shall not apply in or on the
- 15 grounds of the White House, or wherever the United
- 16 States Secret Service is prohibiting the possession of a
- 17 firearm.
- 18 "(2) Subsection (a) shall not apply to a Member of
- 19 Congress while on an air carrier, unless the Secretary of
- 20 Homeland Security finds that the Member of Congress has
- 21 successfully completed the training program established
- 22 under section 44921(c) of title 49.
- 23 "(c) The Chief of the United States Capitol Police
- 24 is authorized to issue a license or permit to carry a con-
- 25 cealed handgun to a Member of Congress for purposes of
- 26 this section, under such terms and conditions and in ac-

- 1 cordance with such criteria as the Chief considers appro-
- 2 priate.
- 3 "(d) The Secretary of Homeland Security shall en-
- 4 sure that the training program established under section
- 5 44921(c) of title 49 is made available to any Member of
- 6 Congress, on request of the Member of Congress.
- 7 "(e) The identification required by this subsection is
- 8 the photographic identification issued by a House of the
- 9 Congress that identifies the person photographed as a
- 10 Member of that House.
- 11 "(f) In this section, the term 'Member of Congress'
- 12 means a Senator or a Representative in, or Delegate or
- 13 Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.".
- 14 (b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
- 15 for such chapter is amended by inserting after the item
- 16 relating to section 926C the following:
 - "926D. Carrying of concealed handguns by Members of Congress.".
- 17 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZING MEMBERS OF CONGRESS TO USE OF-
- 18 FICIAL FUNDS TO PAY FOR FIREARMS TRAIN-
- 19 ING PROGRAM.
- 20 (a) Senators.—The Senators' Official Personnel
- 21 and Office Expense Account may be used to pay for the
- 22 Senator to receive training under the program established
- 23 under section 44921(c) of title 49, United States Code.
- 24 (b) Members of the House of Representa-
- 25 Tives.—Section 101 of the House of Representatives Ad-

- 1 ministrative Reform Technical Corrections Act (2 U.S.C.
- 2 5341) is amended—
- 3 (1) by redesignating subsections (b) through (e)
- 4 as subsections (c) through (f); and
- 5 (2) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-
- 6 lowing new subsection:
- 7 "(b) Firearms Training Program.—The Mem-
- 8 bers' Representational Allowance may be used to pay for
- 9 the Member to receive training under the program estab-
- 10 lished under section 44921(c) of title 49, United States
- 11 Code.".
