# A BILL

To ensure America's law enforcement officers have access to lifesaving equipment needed to defend themselves and civilians from attacks by terrorists and violent criminals.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Lifesaving Gear for
- 5 Police Act".

- 3 (a) Unenforceability of Certain Regulations
- 4 Unless Enacted Into Law.—
- 5 (1) In General.—No regulation, rule, guid-
- 6 ance, policy, or recommendations issued on or after
- 7 May 15, 2015, that limits the sale or donation of
- 8 property of the Federal Government, including ex-
- 9 cess property of the Department of Defense, to
- 10 State and local agencies for law enforcement activi-
- ties (whether pursuant to section 2576a of title 10,
- 12 United States Code, or any other provision of law,
- or as a condition on the use of Federal funds) shall
- have any force or effect after the date of the enact-
- ment of this Act unless enacted into law by Con-
- 16 gress.
- 17 (2) Prohibition on use of funds to en-
- 18 FORCE REGULATIONS.—No agency or instrumen-
- tality of the Federal Government may use any Fed-
- eral funds, fees, or resources to implement or carry
- out a regulation, rule, guidance, policy, or rec-
- ommendation issued as described in subsection (a)
- 23 that is not enacted into law by Congress.
- 24 (b) Return or Reissue of Equipment Recalled
- 25 OR SEIZED PURSUANT TO REGULATIONS.—Any property
- 26 recalled or seized on or after May 15, 2015, pursuant to

- 1 a regulation, rule, guidance, policy, or recommendation
- 2 issued as described in subsection (a) shall be returned, re-
- 3 placed, or re-issued to the agency from which recalled or
- 4 seized, at no cost to such agency, as soon as practicable

5 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
