A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Election Law – County Central Committees – Democratic Party Requirements

- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law concerning the composition of 4 Democratic Party Central Committees in certain counties; requiring the members of $\mathbf{5}$ each county Democratic Party Central Committee to be elected in accordance with 6 certain rules and bylaws; requiring that the method of election of members of each 7 county Democratic Party Central Committee promote geographic balance to the 8 extent practicable; requiring the Democratic State Central Committee to notify the 9 State Board of Elections of the number of elected members for each county Democratic Party Central Committee and the composition of the districts of the 1011 elected members of each county Democratic Party Central Committee not later than 12a certain amount of time before a certain deadline; authorizing a change affecting 13 the method of election of county Democratic Party Central Committee members to 14take effect only after certain actions have been taken; prohibiting a change to the 15method of election of county Democratic Party Central Committee members from 16occurring during an election cycle if the Democratic State Central Committee has 17made a certain notification; and generally relating to Democratic Party Central 18 Committees.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

$\frac{3}{4}$	(1) three members shall be elected from each legislative district wholly contained within Anne Arundel County; and
$5 \\ 6$	(2) one member shall be elected from that portion within Anne Arundel County of any legislative district that is partially contained within Anne Arundel County.
7 8 9	(b) (1) [(i) In Baltimore City, the Democratic Party Central Committee consists of seven members elected from each of the six legislative districts of Baltimore City.

$5\\6\\7$	(4) The number of Democratic Party Central Committee members to be elected from each legislative district, or portion of legislative district, in Baltimore County shall be determined upon completion of each legislative districting.		
8 9	(d) In Calvert County, the Democratic Party Central Committee consists of nine members elected by the voters of the county at large as follows:

18 19	(e)] (D) In Carroll County, the Republican Party Central Committee shall consist of nine members elected at large.		
20	[(f) (1) In Montgomery County, for the Democratic Party Central Committee:

$\begin{array}{c} 23\\ 24 \end{array}$	(ii) one member is elected from the Montgomery County part of each legislative district that is partially within Montgomery County; and		
25 26 27	(iii) members shall be elected at large equal to the number of legislative districts that lie wholly within Montgomery County, except that not more than two members at large may reside in the same legislative district.		
28 29 30	(2) Any vacancy in a seat on the Democratic Party Central Committee held initially by a member elected from a legislative district shall be filled by a person residing in that district.		
31 32 33	(3) Any reference to the Democratic Party Central Committee for Montgomery County or any portion of it means the entire membership of the Montgomery County Democratic Party Central Committee, and in no event do the members of the		

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1	Central Committee elected from a district comprise a separate central committee.
$2 \\ 3$	(g)] (E) (1) [(i)] In Prince George's County, members of the Republican Party Central Committee:
4	[1.] (I) may run at large to fill historically vacant seats; and
5 6 7	[2.] (II) unless a member runs at large under item 1 of this subparagraph, shall be elected from within legislative districts of Prince George's County or within that portion of any legislative district lying within Prince George's County.
8 9 10	[(ii)] (2) The number of members of the Republican Party Central Committee shall, to the extent practicable, consist of two members from each of the eight legislative districts lying within Prince George's County.

1 (2) (i) A candidate for election to the Democratic Party Central 2 Committee shall declare at the time of filing a certificate of candidacy which seat the 3 candidate is seeking.

4 (ii) A member elected to represent a specific county commissioner 5 district who ceases to reside in that district may not continue to serve on the Central 6 Committee.

7 (3) Any vacancy in a seat on the Central Committee held by an individual 8 elected from a county commissioner district shall be filled by an individual who resides in 9 that district.]

10 (F) (1) IN EACH COUNTY, THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC 11 PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL BE ELECTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH:

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- (I) THE PARTY RULES OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY;

13 (II) THE BYLAWS OF THE DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL 14 COMMITTEE; AND

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(III) THE BYLAWS OF EACH COUNTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

16 (2) THE METHOD OF ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF EACH COUNTY 17 DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL PROMOTE GEOGRAPHIC 18 BALANCE TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE.

19 (3) NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR BEFORE THE DEADLINE FOR FILING A 20 CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY UNDER § 5–303(A) OF THIS ARTICLE, THE 21 DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL NOTIFY THE STATE BOARD OF:

22 (I) THE NUMBER OF ELECTED MEMBERS FOR EACH COUNTY 23 DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE; AND

24(II) THE COMPOSITION OF THE DISTRICTS OF THE ELECTED25MEMBERS OF EACH COUNTY DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

26 (4) A CHANGE AFFECTING THE METHOD OF ELECTION OF COUNTY 27 DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS MAY TAKE EFFECT ONLY 28 AFTER:

29 (I) AMPLE ADVANCE WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE CHANGE IS 30 PROVIDED TO THE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS;

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(II) A CHANGE HAS BEEN MADE IN THE BYLAWS OF THE COUNTY

4 (5) A CHANGE TO THE METHOD OF ELECTION OF COUNTY 5 DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS MAY NOT OCCUR DURING AN 6 ELECTION CYCLE IF THE DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAS MADE 7 THE NOTIFICATION REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2020.
