JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to clarify the presidential pardoning power.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States after the date of its submission for ratification:

1 "ARTICLE—

2 "The President shall have no power to grant to him-

3 self a reprieve or pardon for an offense against the United

4 States.".
