## A BILL

- To prohibit the Department of Defense from deploying strategic assets of the United States in the Republic of Turkey.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. FINDINGS.

- 4 Congress finds the following:
- 5 (1) As part of the North Atlantic Treaty Orga6 nization's (NATO) nuclear sharing policy, non-nu7 clear NATO members have hosted United States nu8 clear weapons and associated forces within their re9 spective territories since the 1960s.

1	(2) NATO's nuclear sharing policy was enacted
2	during the Cold War as a means to enhance deter-
3	rence of the Soviet Union by involving non-nuclear
4	NATO allies alongside the United States, the United
5	Kingdom, and France.
6	(3) Turkey has been a member of NATO since
7	the organization's first enlargement in 1952.
8	(4) Turkey's current president Recep Tayyip
9	Erdogan has altered many long-standing Turkish
10	policies and institutions, making the Government of
11	Turkey more authoritarian and Islamist.
12	(5) The failed coup attempt of July 2016 and
13	the subsequent reprisals against suspected partici-
14	pants raise concerns about the stability of the Turk-
15	ish government and the discipline of its military.
16	(6) Turkey continues to develop stronger rela-
17	tions with geopolitical adversaries to NATO such as
18	Russia, China, and Iran.
19	(7) In October 2019, in response to questions
20	about the security of United States strategic assets
21	in Turkey, the President of the United States noted
22	"we're confident, and we have a great—a great air
23	base there, a very powerful air base.".
24	(8) The Incirlik Air Base website states, "The
25	39 Operations Support Squadron leads world-class

airfield & support operations to orchestrate and con trol U.S., Turkish, and coalition forces operating at
 Incirlik Airbase in the execution of full-spectrum air power and nuclear deterrent operations.".

5 (9) Turkey denied the United States access to
6 Incirlik Air Base during the Iraq War in 2003 and
7 refused to allow coalition jets to use Incirlik when
8 ISIS gained ground in Kobani, Syria, in 2014.

9 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR
10 CERTAIN DEPLOYMENT OF STRATEGIC AS11 SETS.

None of the funds authorized to be appropriated or otherwise made available for fiscal year 2020 or any fiscal year thereafter for the Department of Defense may be obligated or expended for the future deployment of any strategic assets of the United States in the Republic of Turkey.

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
