Ms. Duckworth introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation

A BILL

To require the National Institute of Standards and Technology to establish a premise plumbing research laboratory, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "NIST Plumbing Re-
- 5 search Act of 2020".
- 6 SEC. 2. PREMISE PLUMBING RESEARCH.
- 7 (a) Premise Plumbing Defined.—In this Act, the
- 8 term "premise plumbing" means the water distribution
- 9 system located within the property lines of a property, in-
- 10 cluding all buildings and permanent structures on such

- 1 property. Such term includes building supply and distribu-
- 2 tion pipes, fixtures, fittings, water heaters, water-treating
- 3 and water-using equipment, and all respective joints, con-
- 4 nections, devices, and appurtenances.
- 5 (b) RESEARCH.—Not later than 1 year after the date
- 6 of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the National
- 7 Institute of Standards and Technology shall—
- 8 (1) establish or designate a laboratory to con-
- 9 duct research on premise plumbing in relation to
- water safety, security, efficiency, sustainability, and
- 11 resilience;
- 12 (2) conduct an organizational review of all re-
- search and other activities related to premise plumb-
- ing conducted by Federal entities; and
- 15 (3) appoint 1 or more officers or employees of
- the Institute to liaise with non-Federal entities con-
- 17 ducting research or other activities related to
- 18 premise plumbing.
- 19 (c) QUADRENNIAL REPORTS.—Not later than 4 years
- 20 after the date of the enactment of this Act and not less
- 21 frequently than once every 4 years thereafter, the Director
- 22 shall submit to Congress a report on the progress made
- 23 by the Institute regarding—

1	(1) the status of the laboratory described in
2	subsection (b)(1), including any staff designated to
3	work in such laboratory;

- (2) all projects of the Institute related to premise plumbing, including completed projects, projects in progress, and projects planned for the future;
- (3) updates to data relevant to premise plumbing system structure, design, and construction; and
- (4) any progress of private organizations in up-dating premise plumbing standards.
- 12 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There 13 are authorized to be appropriated to the National Institute 14 of Standards and Technology such sums as may be nec-15 essary to carry out this section.
