A BILL

To extend the due date for the return and payment of Federal income taxes to July 15, 2020, for taxable year 2019.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tax Filing Relief for
5 America Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEADLINES FOR TAXABLE YEAR 2019.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—In the case of returns for taxable
3 year 2019, including for purposes of section 6151(a) of
4 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, section 6072(a) of
5 such Code shall be applied—

6 (1) by substituting “July” for “April”; and

7 (2) by substituting “the seventh month” for
8 “the fourth month”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) shall apply to
10 all returns required to be filed for taxable year 2019.

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
