A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to prohibit the misrepresentation of actions on behalf of candidates for purposes of soliciting contributions or donations.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stop Scam PACs Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITING ALL MISREPRESENTATION OF AC-
2	TION ON BEHALF OF CANDIDATES FOR PUR-
3	POSES OF SOLICITING CONTRIBUTIONS OR
4	DONATIONS.
5	(a) Coverage of All Misrepresentation of Ac-
6	TION ON BEHALF OF POLITICAL COMMITTEES.—Section
7	322(b)(1) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971
8	(52 U.S.C. 30124(b)(1)) is amended—
9	(1) by striking "fraudulently"; and
10	(2) by striking "or political party" and insert-
11	ing "or political committee (including a political
12	committee of a political party)".
13	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
14	subsection (a) shall take effect upon the expiration of the
15	90-day period which begins on the date of the enactment
16	of this Act.
