## A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to prohibit the misrepresentation of actions on behalf of candidates for purposes of soliciting contributions or donations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Scam PACs Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING ALL MISREPRESENTATION OF AC-**  
2 **TION ON BEHALF OF CANDIDATES FOR PUR-**  
3 **POSES OF SOLICITING CONTRIBUTIONS OR**  
4 **DONATIONS.**

5 (a) COVERAGE OF ALL MISREPRESENTATION OF AC-  
6 TION ON BEHALF OF POLITICAL COMMITTEES.—Section  
7 322(b)(1) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971  
8 (52 U.S.C. 30124(b)(1)) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “fraudulently”; and

10 (2) by striking “or political party” and insert-  
11 ing “or political committee (including a political  
12 committee of a political party)”.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
14 subsection (a) shall take effect upon the expiration of the  
15 90-day period which begins on the date of the enactment  
16 of this Act.
