 <u>all of the active members of a committee and</u> [CHAIRMAN,] with the concurrence
 of a majority of the active members of the committee and on behalf of the committee,
 may introduce a bill or resolution. Bills and resolutions shall be prepared and
 introduced in the manner and form prescribed in the uniform rules and the legislative
 style manual.
